A LEVEL RESULTS DAY 2022!

- 18th August 2022: find out from your school/college when you will be able to access your results. Some schools may be sending these online this year and others may be open for you to collect them.
- <u>UCAS Track</u> will be open for applicants from 8am. In some cases, it may already show whether or not you have been accepted on your university course. However you may need to allow some time for the decisions to be processed, as each university manages this differently.
- Any correspondence from the university and decisions made will be communicated through UCAS Track, so ensure you know your log in details and your UCAS ID number.

Outcome	What does this mean?
You have an offer!	This means that you have met the conditions of either your Conditional Firm or your Conditional Insurance choices. You will automatically be placed on this course. If you choose to decline this, you will be entered into Clearing.
You have entered Clearing.	This will happen if you did not meet the conditions of your Firm or Insurance courses. You may also place yourself into Clearing if you change your mind and decline your offer. You can do this through Track or by speaking to the university. Clearing shows you courses that UCAS has worked out may be a good fit for you, however you do not need to choose one of these courses.
You have been offered a place on an alternative course.	This may happen if you don't quite meet the requirements for your chosen course but the university is still interested in offering you an alternative pathway. You can either choose to accept or decline this. If you decline it, you can then be entered into Clearing.

There will different possible outcomes on results day:

CLEARING 2022

Your UCAS Track will be updated as to whether you have been entered into <u>Clearing</u>. This will either be because you did not meet the conditions of your offers, or because you have decided to decline your offer. You will be given a clearing number in Track.

You are able to search for course vacancies through UCAS HERE.

Once a vacancy has been found that you are interested in, you will need to call up the university to discuss the possibility of gaining a place. **Universities set up special clearing helplines with plenty of staff on hand to help you.** In 2021, 36,430 students got a university place through clearing so you are not alone in this process.

You will need to give them your Clearing number and UCAS personal ID.

Prepare to tell/ask them:

- Why you are interested in the course.
- Why you are interested in the university.
- Can they offer accommodation?
- Do they need to see your proof of qualifications?

If you are offered a provisional place through Clearing, you'll usually be given a date by which you must enter the course details on your UCAS Track. Universities/colleges will not be able to formalise offers until you have entered the course details into Track
